The conversation, which is made possible by the generous support of the Maison française d'Oxford, will be in French.

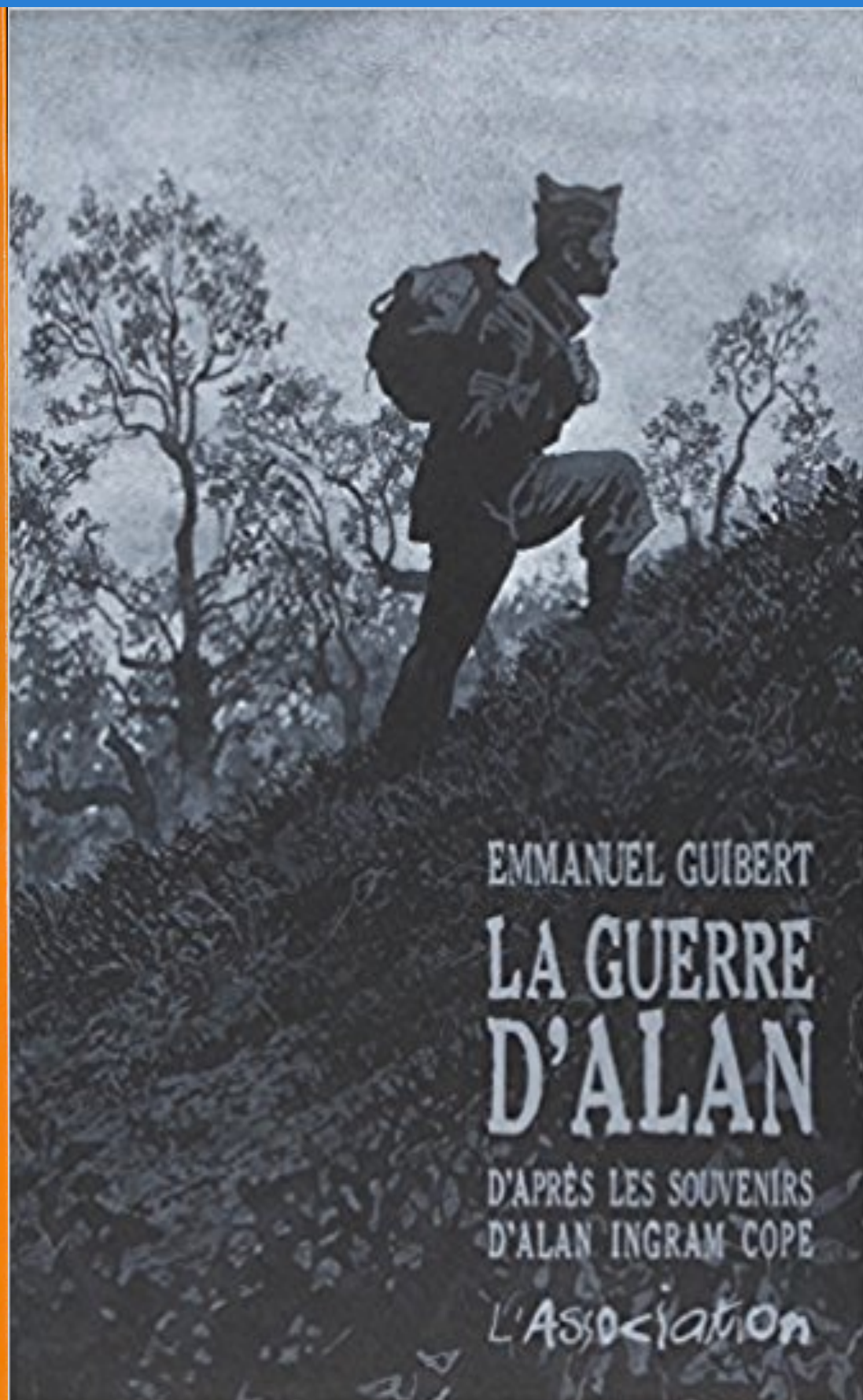
